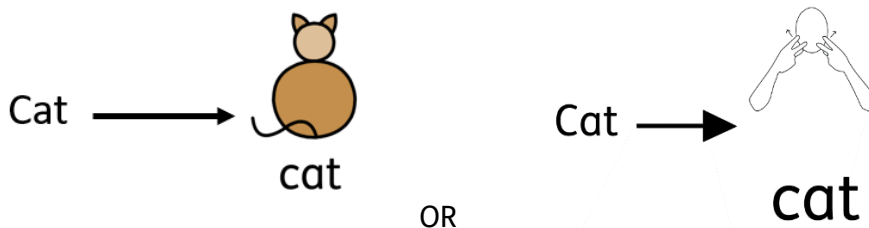




## Installing Makaton for InPrint

### Overview

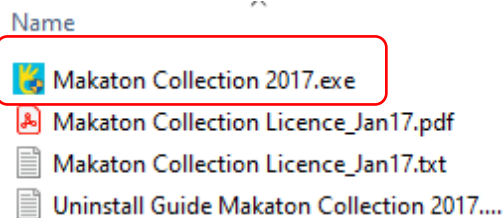
Makaton signs and symbols are a form of **Wordlist**. A **Wordlist** is a file that links words with graphics. If you type 'cat' in **Symbol Mode** while using InPrint 3, the loaded **Wordlist** will automatically display the symbol associated with that word. You can choose to enable or disable different **Wordlists** in InPrint 3, depending on how you wish to use the program.



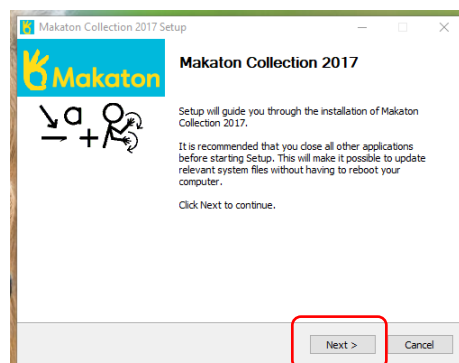
### Installing Makaton

Makaton needs to be installed on the same machine(s) as the InPrint software.

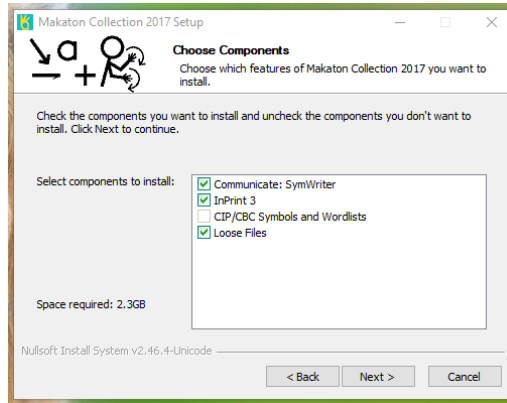
1. Insert the USB and double-click on Makaton Collection 2017



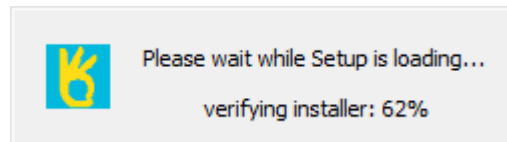
2. Click **Next** when prompted



3. Ensure that you have ticked the relevant box(es) - in this case InPrint 3, and click **Next** until it starts installation.



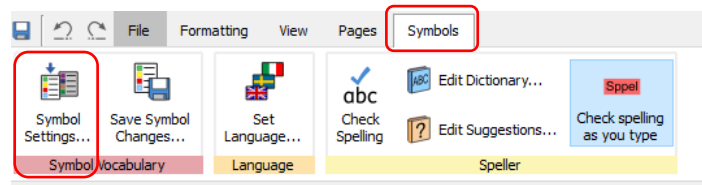
4. You will get a **Wait** message.



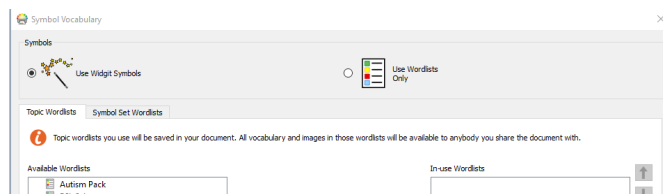
## Loading the Makaton to Wordlists

To load **Makaton Wordlists** for use, you need to have a new blank document open in InPrint.

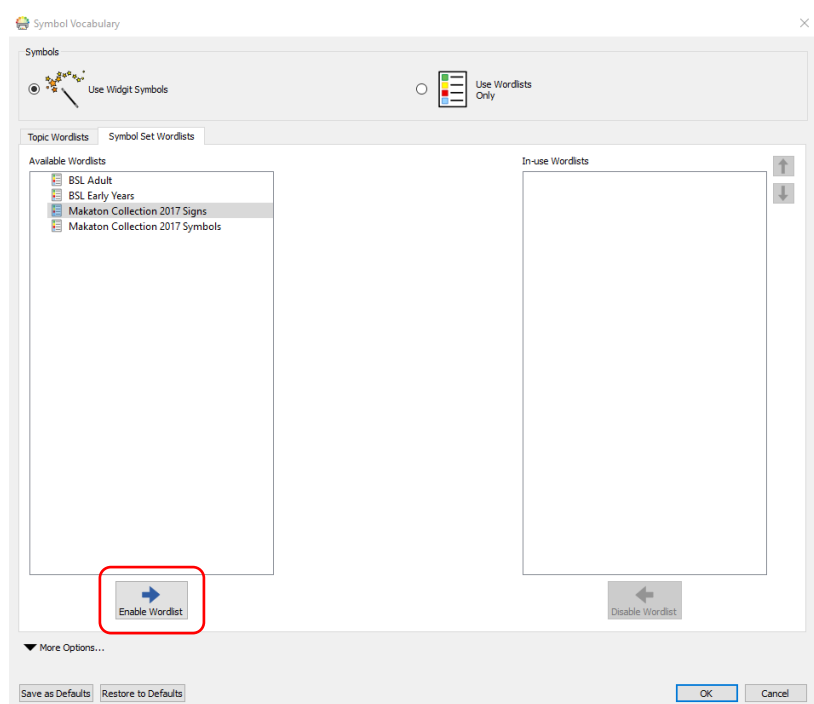
1. Select the **Symbols** tab, and then the **Symbol Settings** button.



2. You will see a pop-up screen.

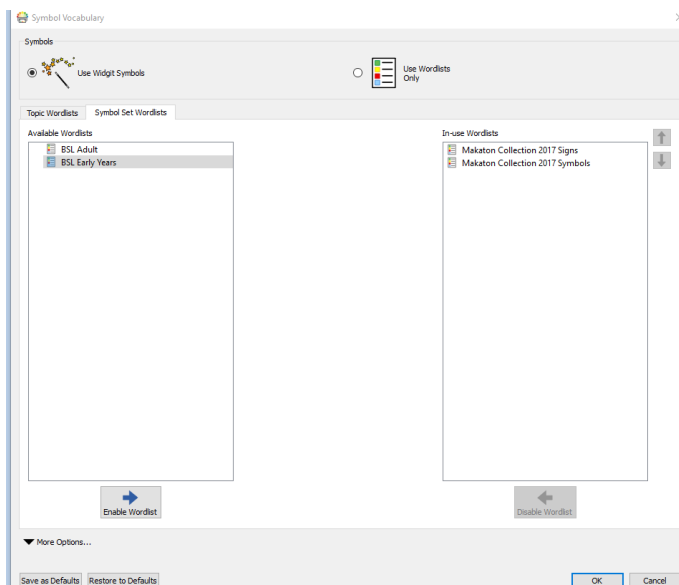


3. Click the **Symbol Set Wordlists** tab. You should see **Makaton Collection 2017 Signs** and **Makaton Collection 2017 Symbols**. If you have bought any others, they should be displayed here also. Click to select a **Wordlist**, then click the **Enable Wordlist** button.

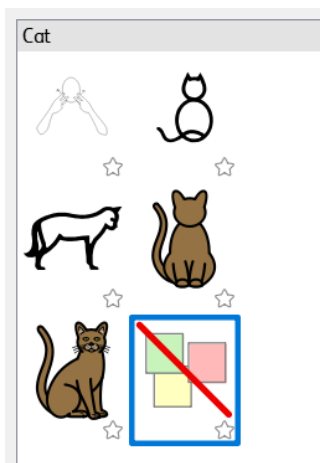
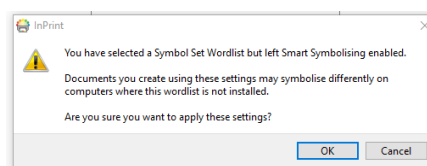


4. Once any/all lists you wish to use are displayed in the right-hand box, click **OK**

**NOTE: If you want to permanently have a wordlist in use click the Save as Defaults button.**



5. You may see this warning. Simply click **OK**.



Now when you type into a document, there will be Makaton options alongside the Widgit Symbols:
